

"We believe in God . . . the Almighty," we pray at Mass every Sunday: We believe God to be allpowerful—to think anything less would mean God isn't God. If we look at the world around us, though, we see bad things happening to just about everyone. Where is the Almighty in all that? The church's answer has always been that "God grants his creatures . . . the dignity of acting on their own," as the Catechism of the Catholic Church says.
