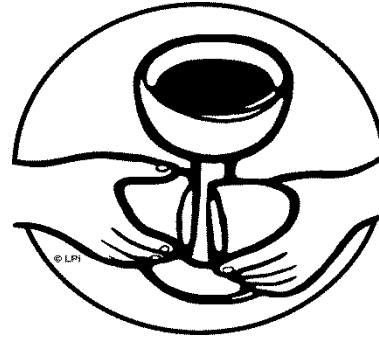

Welcome to St. Columba's Religious Education program. Thank you for entrusting your children to us to complement your family faith formation.

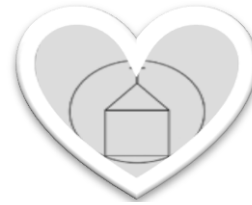
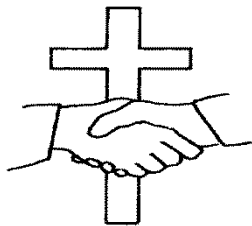
Our program is made up of a devoted group of volunteers with a strong focus on service to our church family and our community.

We ask this through your Son, Jesus Christ.

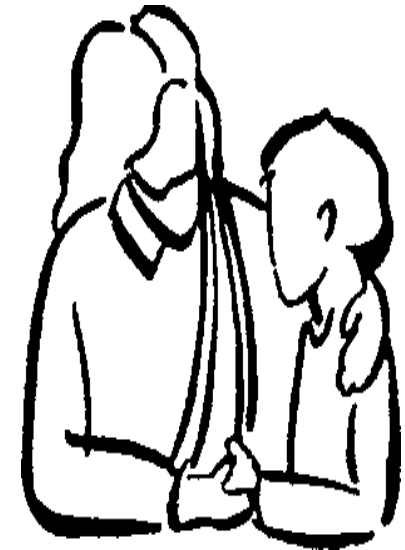
